Rules and regulations

1. Main event Saturday August 19, \$150 entry fee. Pay out top 3 teams...we are working on getting prizes for 4th to 10th

1st place \$3,500 2nd place \$2,000 3rd \$1040 charter mobynick.com

\$50 Calcutta full pay back side bet for 2 heaviest fish per team on Saturday (optional)

2. There will be a big fish Friday August 18th (\$50/team). \$800 to Heaviest Salmon, \$400 to Heaviest Trout, rest goes to G.T.A.A. conservation projects and operating costs. Your team must be registered for Saturday's tournament to qualify for Big Fish Friday. 4 rod max.

3. Prizes will be based on a team's best 5 fish, consisting of 5 legally caught fish. Teams may enter up to 4 trout (as long as their licenses allow for it) but 5th fish must be a salmon or all 5 can be salmon.

2 rods rods per boat, an extra \$50 per rod up to 4 maximum

Any team using 3 rods pays extra \$50

Any team using 4 rods pays extra \$100

4. All entrants' boats to be inspected on Both Friday and Saturday morning before takeoff. Cooler/boat check by captains and GTAA Volunteers no later than 4:45am (in water inspections only) no boats loaded with coolers after check.

5. Captains meeting 5:15am sharp Captains must be at meeting to receive their tags that are to be affixed to there Big Fish on Friday and to 2 heaviest fish Saturday that are to be entered for Calcutta side bet.

6. Take off will be at 6:00am August 18th & 19th (Money refunded if Slam officials cancels one of the days due to weather). Return time 2:00pm, team coolers must be in weigh line 2:30pm or will be penalized (1lb/1min late).

7. 1 Team member must be with your cooler or box at all times while waiting to weigh-in, any team not doing so will be disqualified.

8. Each boat's tournament registration # must be affixed to your vessel at all times in a visible manner.

9. Only legally caught fish may be entered. All MNRF fishing regulations must be followed.

10. All Boater safety rules must be followed (safety equipment, life jackets & safe boating practices).

11. vhf channel 71 is used in the Collingwood area and will be monitored by organizers.

12. Eligible waters are Georgian Bay proper. Team's may go anywhere on Georgian Bay during the tournament but must take off from and return to Collingwood Harbor.

13. You MUST return under your own power. Any team not returning under their own power will be disqualified. Any team willing to tow in a disabled vessel must return to the Harbor and drop off a team member with their cooler of fish before towing in the disabled vessel or they will be disqualified also.

Big fish Friday up to 4 rods included with your \$50 entry fee.

\$50 cash Calcutta to be paid Sat August 19 at Captains Meeting.

There will not be an alternate date if Officials cancel due to weather.

In the event of cancellation your money will be refunded for day or days canceled.
